This pattern was created to celebrate the launch of the new Scheepjes Little Darling yarn - the softly sprinkled gradient edition. I had the absolute joy of designing all six sprinkled shades in this collection, and I truly hope you'll love them as much as I do! Designing them was no easy task: anyone who knows me knows that if it were up to me, every colourway would have had a touch of pink!

To complement these new shades, I'm also releasing three free mood-changing patterns! These fun designs can be turned inside out, showing an angry face on one side and a happy face on the other.

- **MR** - Magic ring
- **Sc** - Single crochet
- **Inc** - Increase
- **Hdc** - Half double crochet
- **Dc** - Double crochet
- **Tc** - Triple crochet

MATERIALS

- Yarn
 - Little Darling Strawberry Lemonade - yellow and pink (15g)
 - Little Darling Snow Cone - rainbow (15g)
 - Little Darling Bumble Bee - yellow (5g)
 - A thin black yarn to embroider the face
- 3.5 mm hook
- Darning needle
- Scissors
- Stitch marker
- Two pairs of 8 mm safety eyes
- Lighter (optional, to flatten the ends of safety eyes)

PATTERN

BODY

Make one in strawberry lemonade and one in snow cone:

- 1.** 8 in a MR
- 2.** 8 inc = 16
- 3.** (1 sc, 1 inc) x 8 = 24
- 4.** (3 sc, 1 inc) x 6 = 30
- 5.** (4 sc, 1 inc) x 6 = 36
- 6.** (8 sc, 1 inc) x 4 = 40
- 7.-10.** 40 sc (4 rows!)
- 11.** (8 sc, 1 dec) x 4 = 36
- 12.** (7 sc, 1 dec) x 4 = 32

In the next round, stitches between square brackets should all be placed in the same stitch of row 12:

- 13.** (sc, [hdc, dc, tc], [tc, dc, hdc,], sc) x 8 = 64



Fasten off the yarn. You do not need to leave a tail for sewing.

Place your safety eyes between rows 8 and 9, 9 stitches apart. Consider using your lighter to *melt* the back of the safety eyes and push them flat. Crochet a happy smile on one of the bodies and a sad face on the other. I crocheted a V and an upside down V between the eyes over row 9, 2 stitches wide.



PATTERN

COMBINING

You will now attach both sides to one another. Align the legs of both bodies with one another: one octo should be upside down. Make sure the faces are not directly underneath each other, as the safety eyes will be in each other's way if you do so.



Slip knot the yellow yarn onto your hook. Crochet through the last row of both octos at the same time, making sure the legs stay aligned: 64 sc.



When you've gone all the way around, slip stitch into the first stitch, fasten off and weave in the ends.
